We are a **SELF CONTAINED** band. Meaning we provide everything that is needed for the performance – Full Sound & Lighting Rigs for both stage and dance floor.

Requests are never overlooked as where Wi Fi is available we can download any song requested if it's not already in our library.

If both afternoon and evening entertainment are booked, a 10% discount is applied to the whole fee.

You will only have one act to pay and deal with on the night

Frequently Asked Questions

Some common questions you may have

What time will the band arrive?

We will usually arrive and set-up from 6pm onwards. **This can be changed to earlier if needed. Please note that an hourly rate of £60 is charged for every hour before 6pm.**

How long does it take the band to set up?

We take an hour and a half to set up and sound check. Lifts or stairs may increase load in time.

How long will the band play for?

We are very flexible with our sets and we offer a wide variety of set lengths for Evening and Afternoon entertainment.

How long are the intervals?

We request intervals of at least 15 minutes but this can be longer to suit your requirements on the day

What time should the band start playing?

This is completely up to you and your schedule on the day. We find it's often best to start the band at around 9pm but this is purely a guide. We also find it's best to serve the buffet during the band breaks or before the band start. Again this is completely flexible.

Does the band provide music between and before sets?

Yes, We offer a complimentary Dj Service. We have a full lighting rig and a professional DJ App on an iPad which we use to manually mix music for the evening. Requests are never overlooked as where Wi Fi is available we can download any song requested if we don't already have it!

Will the band require refreshments?

We request that the band is provided with soft drinks throughout our stay at the venue. We also request food for 4 members of the band. This doesn't have to be to the same standard as your guest's meal, just something before we play to keep energy levels up.

Can I come and watch the band play live before I book?

Unfortunately Off The Cuff are purely a private function band playing only 'closed to the public' shows.

Do you do requests and first dances?

Absolutely! We will endeavor to learn any requests/first dances. Requests are required to be kept to a maximum of 3 songs with at least 4 weeks notice before the event.

Do you offer discounts on afternoon and evening sets?

Yes we do, we can offer a package for your event where we can play background music for your guests, as well as the main evening entertainment for a discounted price. If you have booked another wedding band for any part of your day, we will still be happy to be your afternoon or evening wedding/party entertainment.

Does the band provide their own PA system / Lighting equipment?

Yes, we are completely self-contained so you don't need to worry about a thing. We use a top class Mackie PA system with access to larger systems for events over 600 people. We also provide a full lighting rig for the stage and dancefloor.

Do we need to hire a stage?

No, a stage is always a great addition to a performance but is not a requirement.

How much space do you require?

We are very accommodating when it comes to space however if you believe space may be an issue, please contact us to discuss.

What are the minimum power requirements?

We require at least 2 independent 13 amp sockets. If your marquee company has requested details, please advise that our PA system and lighting use approximately 2.5kw and a single 16amp power supply is not sufficient.

Is the bands equipment PAT tested and Insured?

Yes, if the venue requires a certificate, please contact us and we'll forward you copy.
We also have public Liability insurance worth £10,000,000.00.

How do I confirm a booking?

We will send you a contract/Invoice which will require a deposit and signed returned contract. Once these have been received, you will be emailed a booking confirmation and receipt confirming your deposit and booking.
